Race HQ

The event is based at the Bandstand at Chatham Maritime next to Basin 2. Race HQ is located inside the blue marquee. Race HQ will be open from 9:00am on Sunday 8th April. You will need to collect your number and timing chip from here. Inside the Race HQ you will find several desks for collections – please select the desk appropriate to your SURNAME for collection, NOT your first name or club/company name. Please make sure you allow enough time to collect these. The race starts at 10:30am.

Timing Chips

PLEASE NOTE: The timing chip you are issued with must be returned to us at the end of the 10k, just after you finish. Unfortunately missing or lost chips will incur a £10 charge. Thank you for your assistance with this.

Refreshments

We will have a great range of coffees, teas and other refreshments together with hot food and even ice-creams!! Fingers crossed for sunshine!

Changing Rooms & Toilets

There are toilets available, but unfortunately no changing facilities at this venue.

Parking

The Chatham Maritime Trust has made several free car parks available to us. Spaces are limited, so we would advise car sharing where possible. Please follow the directions of marshals upon arrival. The post code for your sat nav if travelling by car is ME4 4QZ. This is near to the Dockside Shopping Centre just before the bridge across to St. Mary's Island. There are additional car parks available within a few minutes walk.

Baggage Drop

We will have a baggage drop. You **must bring your race number** with you to show when depositing your bags and belongings. Please note bags and belongings are stored at your own risk.

Prizes & Presentation

Every finisher will receive a unique medal specially commissioned for the race. There will be prizes and a presentation at approximately 11:45 near to the race finish line. There are prizes for 1st/2nd/3rd Male and Female, 1st Vet 40, 50 and 60 Male and Female. Please do stay for this and cheer on everyone's successes.
